The skills components of the course will include explaining arbitration to a hypothetical client, drafting an arbitration clause, participating in a mock arbitration, and drafting a motion to confirm an arbitration award. Although it will be demanding, this course will give you an excellent, practical introduction to international commercial arbitration.
